About a year ago, we raised the concern whether FACA applies to the e-bike interagency/partner group. NPS said we were okay.

Now more than ever, I increasingly feel uneasy about FS participation...especially since:

- a gov't agency continues to 'host' mtgs & develop agendas;
- it's not an open mtg (when the only partners at the table are e-bike/mtn bike advocacy groups; one of which, P4B, is aggressively lobbying at state and federal levels to change policy); and,
- we often discuss current federal policy w/ advocates providing recommendations to agencies.

To ensure we are FACA compliant (esp given DOIs recent S.O. release and the continued conversation surrounding policy of this group), I would recommend a definitive determination from OGC.
