This email is in response to your hotline complaint #202301300 you submitted to Naval Inspector General on 5 April 2023 regarding allegations of inaccurate statements concerning the cleanup and re-testing of parcels at Hunters Point Naval Shipyard (HPNS).

Currently, there are 12 active lawsuits filed in the United States District Court for the Northern District of California in San Francisco, arising out of or connected to former HPNS. The Department of the Navy is party in six of the lawsuits. Due to the open litigation, we determined that an investigation will not be opened and we will take no action at this time.
