Hi Linda,

I think the proper approach right now is to advise them that we cannot consider an application for co-location until a ROW permit has been issued to Verizon for the proposed tower. That probably wont be completed for another 6 months from now. ROW permit applications are always an extra load on the Superintendents, park and region staff. They are something that NPS policy and the Telecommunications Act require us to respond to so we do not really have any authority to tell a company they cannot submit an application in almost all cases. If I advise AT&T or any other potential future interested cellular carrier that the Verizon tower cannot exceed 60 ft. and they determine that co-location is not feasible, they may then submit an application for a separate tower which is a conversation we all had a long time ago with Tim Gilk when we talked to Region's leadership about the need for towers to be taller if we want all commercial carriers to be located on a single structure. Lets see what AT&T says when I advise them about the 60' height restriction and the point that we cannot consider a Co-location application until Verizon's permit is issued. Our Lands Division can assist you with any applications for ROW permits and will give you as much support as our staffing capacity will allow.
