This letter responds to your Maryland Public Information Act (“MPIA”)<sup>1</sup> request dated November 16, 2022, regarding Maryland’s Renewable Portfolio Standard. Specifically, you requested the aggregate price data for 2021 renewable energy credits (“RECs”) by fuel source.

In response to your MPIA request, the Commission’s Office of the Executive Secretary provides that the aggregate price data for 2021 RECs by fuel source is as follows:
