2. Lobbying and talking about '05 budget.
 - A. What we most need is an infusion of people and \$8 Million
3. Insubordination.
 - A. Refused to transfer Blyth on August 25 - told to do it on August 18.
4. Violating chain of command
 - A. Went to Griles about Blyth transfer.
5. Insubordination.
 - A. Refused to tell Pettiford and Beam to have their psychological test done.

Don Murphy's draft directions:

1. No more instances of insubordination.
2. Must attend all NLC and Associates Meetings unless excused by Director or DM.
3. Must cooperate with NAPA and not get others to interfere or prevent it.
4. No communication with Congress without prior approval by Congressional Affairs Office.
5. No media contact without prior approval as to contact and content.
6. Transfer Blyth for 120 days.
7. Understand and follow chain of command: DM, FM, PH
8. Attend weekly meeting with LP and DM and cooperate with regard to mission / budget review.
