
Dear Mr. Phillips:

This is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of June 21, 2005, regarding agency records identifying the dollar amount of federal grant monies paid to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FLDEP) NESHAP program.

The EPA provides grant money to the FLDEP to support their air pollution control program and does not specifically track money spent within its Section 105 (CAA) grants. Therefore, I wish to advise you that the EPA, Region 4 has no records responsive to your request. If you consider this response to be a denial, you may appeal this no records determination to EPA, Office of Environmental Information, Records, Privacy, and FOIA Branch (2822T), 1200 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, DC 20460. The appeal must be made in writing, and it must be received at this address no later than 30 calendar days from the date of this letter. The Agency will not consider appeals received after the 30-day limit. The appeal may include as much or as little related information as you wish, as long as it clearly identifies the determination being appealed (including the assigned FOIA request number - 04-RIN-00667-05). For quickest possible handling, the appeal letter and its envelope should be marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
