air monitoring is being conducted by the General Services Administration.

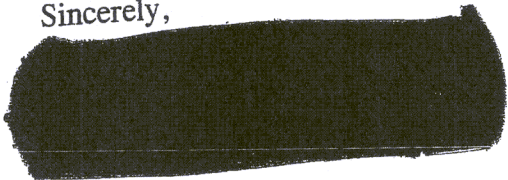
