There is no public hearing at this stage in the Commission's review of allegations of violations of the Conflicts Law. A hearing, which is public, only occurs after a complaint is issued, and the Commission can but has not, in the last 20 or so years, conducted that hearing. The hearing takes place at the Office of Administrative Law.

The Commission does not ordinarily permit public comment at its meetings, nor is it required to do so by the Open Public Meetings Act.

Your exchange with the Chair in July is not part of the record of that meeting because there was no eligible quorum present. My recollection of a discussion about a future exchange is that you would be interviewed by an investigator and should present your comments at that time. Nevertheless, the staff acted on your request from earlier today and forwarded it to the Commission. In addition, you should be aware that the documents you submitted have been made available to the Commission. Rita Strmensky
