Ethics Meeting - Review of Ethics Model Practices

SUMMARY

On October 26, 2006, I discussed an assessment of the Department of the Interior ethics program based on a review of ethics model practices and provided you with an action plan for deliverables. Previously, you requested an assessment of the Ethics Program Model Practices provided to DOI by Robert Cusick, Director of the Office of Government Ethics. You requested information on how many of the practices are currently in place and an action plan for implementing some of the other model practices into the DOI ethics program.
