Follow up information as requested leftover from last night in Bozeman:

1) The NPS has 188 cell phones, Xanterra 26 & DN 15 for a total of 229

2) Cell Tower installations: - Current OF & Grant Cell towers were relocated from the lower locations to the current locations in 2001. I have not been able to yet discover the original Comnet installs but it was prior to 1998, the earliest stuff I've seen yet.

3) Elk Plaza went in in 2000, just before OF & Grant.

4) Bunsen Peak was the first tower and was followed by Mt. Washburn. Years still unknown but prior to 1998.
