1 At the end, add the following: TITLE IX—MISCELLANEOUS 2 3 SEC. 901. USE OF FIREARMS IN UNITS OF THE NATIONAL 4 PARK SYSTEM AND THE NATIONAL WILDLIFE 5 **REFUGE SYSTEM.** 6 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds that— 7 (1) the second amendment to the Constitution provides that "the right of the people to keep and 8 9 bear Arms, shall not be infringed";

2	eral Regulations, provides that "except as otherwise
3	provided in this section and parts 7 (special regula-
4	tions) and 13 (Alaska regulations), the following are
5	prohibited: (i) Possessing a weapon, trap or net (ii)
6	Carrying a weapon, trap or net (iii) Using a weapon,
7	trap or net";
8	(3) section 27.42 of title 50, Code of Federal

 the second amendment rights of an individual at a
 unit of the National Park System or the National
 Wildlife Refuge System should not be infringed.

5 (b) PROTECTING THE RIGHT OF INDIVIDUALS TO
6 BEAR ARMS IN UNITS OF THE NATIONAL PARK SYSTEM
7 AND THE NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE SYSTEM.—The
8 Secretary of the Interior shall not promulgate or enforce
9 any regulation that prohibits an individual from pos10 sessing a firearm in any unit of the National Park System
11 or the National Wildlife Refuge System if—

12 (1) the individual is not otherwise prohibited by13 law from possessing the firearm; and

14 (2) the possession of the firearm is in compli15 ance with the law of the State in which the unit of
16 the National Park System or the National Wildlife
17 Refuge System is located.
