Tom - I spoke with Ed today regarding the meeting with Santorum, Specter, Sherwood, and the Governor. They discussed the following issues: (1) The Ombudsman issue: Ed said the Governor is committed to not putting Kaufman back and will instead put another person in his place from the IG's office. (2) Tranguch: Ed said that the Senators raised the issue that while 400 homes have been inspected, only 27 homes have received any kind of report from EPA. He said the Governor was very concerned that the process of getting these families the information was taking too long. He did not refer to any specific follow-up to the meeting, but certainly we may want to see why the process is taking as long as it is and how to remedy it. Let me know if you need any additional information or want me to follow-up in any way.
