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- Century Link (fiber) Potential Services (Bret). CenturyLink held a meeting on July 15 at the Canyon VEC where they discussed potential services that could be provided to the park if an optic fiber route was built in Yellowstone. If optic fiber carriers were installed along the existing South Entrance, Grand Loop roads, and North Entrance roads or along existing power line right of ways, available services could include up to 40 mg DSL, fiber to tower, 100mg Ethernet, and GPON at Norris, Madison, Old Faithful, and Grant Village. Given the high costs for compliance and construction in Yellowstone, CL is looking for aid in construction from interested parties e.g. concessioners, cellular service providers, utility service providers, and the NPS. CL will discuss with each customer, their anticipated service needs for the next 10 years.
