Dear Secretary Salazar:

On behalf of everyone at PPL, and on behalf of Ralph LaRossa and his team at PSE&G, I am writing to express our sincere gratitude for a very productive meeting on the Susquehanna-Roseland power line project on August 4, 2011. We appreciated your expression of support for critical energy infrastructure projects – built and managed in ways that preserve, conserve and honor the unique public values of the federal lands managed by the Interior Department.

Your personal involvement in this issue has been extremely valuable. We look forward to working with members of your staff, and with everyone at the National Park Service, as we move forward with the Environmental Impact Statement. We greatly appreciate your stated intention to marshal Department resources to conclude the decision-making process and issue a Record of Decision by October 1, 2012. Issuance of the permits and related approvals from the Department by this date will allow us to move forward to meet our federal reliability obligations to the region's electric customers.

Please allow us to assure you, as we did during our meeting, that our proposal for the Susquehanna-Roseland project anticipates fulfilling the most exacting standards for conservation and mitigation. The non-impairment mandate that guides National Park Service decisions sets a demanding threshold for our project, but we are determined to meet it.
