

## Sample Project #1:

Earlier this month, we were awarded a contract to appraise (11) wireless-telecommunications facilities and 55 miles of linear right-of-way for a fiberoptic-cable conduit within the Grand Teton National Park in Wyoming. The (11) telecommunications sites will each have a tower, equipment shelter and a generator shed. Eight (8) of these facilities are designed as 80' unipole towers painted brown to match the surrounding pine trees, two are designed as 80'-tall stealth flagpoles, and one site has a standard monopole with privacy fencing. Each facility is designed to accommodate up to four carriers. The primary power source will be the existing utilities found at each site. The general location of these sites is shown over the next two pages.
