Subject: bulls island / land use meeting

dave,

i met with land use regulation yesterday (Rick Reilly, Lou Cattuna). I brought them up to speed after they asked questions regarding the prescription. their questions were:

- why are you doing it?
- what's wrong with the trees?
- how many acres?
- how close to water?
- how are you going to do it?
- what about planting?

i also gave rick a copy of the report. rick mentioned they will help us and we would have to do a full application and go for a hardship / emergency permit. i mentioned that when we did the exemptions for clearcutting in flood hazard areas / wetlands due to storm events / insects / flooding etc were included. he asked for a copy of our letter to the consultants and i provided one to him. i can give you a copy as well. i mentioned our plan, to be exempt from a full application, would be the prospectus for the proposed harvest. not sure what input they will have - maybe none. he is going to visit the site after contacting the maintenance staff. he lives close to the island.

lets meet up and go over next steps...formal proposal and contact with BMPs (jack / mike / jon) and regen plan you discussed.
