As we discussed, I recommend starting the repair process of the Camp Derricotte water tank by having a thorough cleaning & inspection. DEQ suggests having tanks inspected every five years. I do not know when this tank was last inspected. The tank inspector will provide you with a report following the inspection detailing their findings. This report should provide you with the information you will need to determine extent of the damage and if a repair is necessary. Be sure in your bid request to require that they provide a report with photos and recommendations.

With DEQ closely watching this site, this would be a positive step for us. You will be able to kill two birds with one stone on this one.

Yes I hope to have a statewide contract for all tanks to be inspected on a five year cycle in place before the end of the recreational season. If the Derricotte tank is holding up then I agree that it would be advantageous to wait for the statewide inspector to come out this fall/winter as it should be less expensive. The only concern I have is with the current state of the system and the rash of bad samples. If the chlorine system, after everything is up and running the way it should, works and our bacteriological samples consistently come back good, then I have no problem waiting for the inspection...But if the sample continue to come back bad we will need to continue to take strives to address any and all possible concerns. This would likely require having the tank inspected before the end of the recreational season along with a thorough inspection of the distribution system.

We will continue to keep in touch. How are the kayak rentals coming?
